

# Finney's Microporous Hardwax Oil

Sheen levels available: **Original** - Ultra Matt, Matt, Satin

Sheen levels in **Natural Light** - lower colour change formula: Satin, Ultra Matt

## What does it do?

**Finney's Microporous Hardwax Oil** gives a superb natural looking appearance to wood and a silky smooth finish. It can be used as a single coat product and for more protection, 2 to 3 coats or more can be applied.

The **Original** formula darkens the wood like wetting, to pull out maximum grain pattern and colour. It is particularly suitable for darker, dense woods such as walnut, where most Hardwax oils will have problems drying.

Where more of the natural colour of pale wood is preferred, the **Natural Light** version should be used.

## What is it used for?

**Finney's Microporous Hardwax Oil** is used on worktops, fine furniture, stair parts and doors.

## How do you use it?

**Finney's Microporous Hardwax Oil** is very easy to use. It can be wiped on using a **Lint Free Cotton Cloth** or brushed on using a **Deluxe Varnish Brush**. Stir well and always apply in thin applications working along the grain.

In between coats, lightly cut the surface back using **400 grit Lubrisil Abrasive Paper**, removing any dust with a **Tack Cloth**.

## How long does it take to dry?

Very quick for an oil based finish. Generally 2 to 4 hours for thin coats at room temperature.

## Staining

- The best stain to use is **Finney's Professional Water Stains** as these are fully compatible and will not lift from the surface during applications of **Finney's Microporous Hardwax Oil**. Testing should be carried out before use, especially when using **Natural Light**.

## How much do I need?

Coverage on a porous wood such as pine is approximately 10sq m per litre per coat but 12 to 14 sq m per litre per coat can be achieved on timbers such as oak or walnut.
